

## ST AGATHA'S NOVENA – 2<sup>nd</sup> FEBRUARY 2024

### THE POWER OF INTERCESSION AND THE ROSARY – GEORGINA LIVESEY

I was born on 4th July 1942, Park Road, Kingston, baptised in St AGATHAS church November 1942, my mother was married not to my father, her Chinese husband was a prisoner of war in Singapore, she had an affair with my father and conceived me. In the past she had had abortions but failed to abort me, this changed her life. She was not baptised and had other affairs.

She was stuck in England because of the war, she had a friend called Bridget Hegarty, a catholic nurse who was a prisoner of war in Singapore. She prayed the rosary for my mother's conversion. She survived the war.

Once when I was praying, I had a vision of me in my mother's womb in a cave protected by Our Lady. When I was older my mother showed me her abortion instrument. After the war there was a divorce and my parents eventually married. My father brought me up as a catholic. He was an airman who had survived two crashes and had been a prisoner in Germany. He had always carried a miraculous medal on him which I still have.

When I was 11 my mother became a catholic. When she went to confession, she wept full of repentance. She visited Lourdes and Walsingham and after that we had family rosary every night. When I was 13, I went with the school to WALSINGHAM. This is our national shrine of our lady, in NORFOLK. Since then, I have been to Walsingham many times, run retreats and been part of NEW DAWN, a charismatic conference in august in the shrine. I am also an intercessor for the shrine.

As a family we have attended NEW DAWN conferences for many years. It's a family conference with children/teenage streams; they loved it - in fact my son WILLIAM met his wife ELISA, there when they were children.

I married in 1971. We have 6 children; all went to school in St Agathas. In 1985 Fr O Hanlon, came to our parish as a curate, also to Tolworth; we shared him. He was a Marian priest and started rosary groups in our homes. I was part of a home group who prayed in Bridget CUMISKYS, home in Tudor Drive. She was very ill with cancer and eventually died but had a great conversion. There were rosary house groups in Surbiton, the fruit of these rosaries was the formation of a community, Divine Innocence, who pray for the unborn, and still do a prayer walk every first Friday in reparation for abortion from St Raphael's to Our Lady Immaculate. The DIVINE INNOCENCE community is still going strong. At home we had family rosary. I remember one of my sons using the baby's toes for a decade.

When I WAS 45, I worked in Kingston hospital chaplaincy, for ten years. Everyone I saw was given a miraculous medal on a blue string; patients would come in years later still wearing the medal.

I ran out of medals once and gave patients scapulars instead; one patient screamed at me and refused my visit; I LEFT A GREEN SCAPULAR on her table when she slept. The following week she called me over and thanked me, it had changed her life. I gave FR CREMIN one, he was much changed by this.

In 1830, in Paris at the rue du bac, our LADY appeared to CATHERINE

LABOURE. She sat in a chair and talked to CATHERINE; she asked her to have the miraculous medal made. It is a sacramental sign of inward grace, those who wear it have powerful protection from our lady.

We worshipped at St ANN'S Kingston Hill, which was built by Father CREMIN. FR Michael Gwinnell came to our parish and thus began 20 yrs. of working with him. I HELPED him in his ministry of healing and deliverance and family tree masses. Many rosaries were said and we travelled to many countries, teaching spiritual warfare. We were asked to lead a team to pray round Paris for 7 days (JERICHO PRAYER, JOSHUA 6 V1-21,)

We used many hundreds of miraculous medals as we travelled and many rosaries were said.

Eventually we did this prayer for LONDON. In 2005, there was a bomb attack in TAVISTOCK SQ, we were round the corner at the day of renewal, which is a day of prayer, praise and worship. The LORD asked us to pray for LONDON'S protection against terrorism. We began with JERICHO PRAYER, Joshua 6 v1 -16, round the M 25, 7 TIMES THEN 7 TIMES IN ONE DAY, We prayed many rosaries and distributed many medals. Since then, we have prayed every month and still do - not only on the M25, but in the centre of London. In fact, last Sunday we were at Tyburn doing this. There have been minor terrorist incidents but nothing serious. One incident was outside parliament when a car ploughed into the pavement and a policeman died. Some people were thrown into the river. It was the exact spot where we start our rosary outside parliament, praying against abortion. We asked GOD why did that happen as we have been faithful in prayer. He said they were about to pass a bill in parliament allowing full term abortion. That wasn't passed because they closed parliament.

We also pray outside abortion clinics including IPPF head office for the world. A SATANIST once trying to do an abortion as part of a ritual in a clinic failed 3 times because they could see people praying the rosary outside.

Present day I PRAY THE ROSARY for my neighbours, and walk my local streets praying for them. Also, when I DO SCHOOL PICK UP, praying for the children etc. ALSO, when driving I pray the rosary and also the divine mercy as I DRIVE sometimes with a CD.

We now have 1st Saturday devotions in the church after mass. OUR LADY OF FATIMA asked for this for peace - rosary, confession communion an act of reparation for sins against the IMMACULATE HEART of Mary, 15 min meditation. I have just come back from a conference of church leaders, the teaching was based on our times, we started with prophecies from POPE Pius 10th St John Paul 2, pope BENEDICT, ALL SAYING, THAT WE ARE COMEING INTO A TIME OF GREAT TRIBULATION, REALLY AS PROPHECISED at FATIMA, Teaching was on how to prepare and also to see the St signs of our times, saying the rosary, confession, repentance etc.

There are many more things I COULD SAY, but really this is all about getting you to say the rosary for your families and much more.
